Reports & Communications:

A. Purchase of a Gas Sensing equipment for the Screen Building

The old equipment was installed in 2013. The company was sold, and now the equipment is not supported by the factory. Gas sensing equipment is necessary to protect the workers entering the room to maintain the equipment. Two quotes were obtained. One includes installation, and the other is for the equipment only.

Recommended action: Council will consider approving the purchase of gas sensing equipment from USA Bluebook for \$10,846.20.

B. Installation of an Exhaust Fan at Cushman Lift Station

The old equipment was removed when the roof was redone last year. The exhaust fan moves sewer gas from the wet well portion of the station during inspections and cleanings.

Recommended action: Council will consider approving the purchase and installation of an exhaust fan from RW LaPine for \$6,406.00.
