The City will do its best to ensure that the happiness, well-being and safety of our residents by enforcing the Ordinances of the City of Plainwell. We offer the following...

This is a list of the most common ordinance issues:

- Unregistered and/or inoperable vehicles are not permitted.
- Vehicles cannot be parked on front yards.
- Boat / RV / Trailer must be stored properly.
- Grass and/or weeds, including all curb-lawn areas should not exceed 6 inches.
- Bushes, trees, flowers should not obstruct sidewalks.
- Garbage Dumpsters should not be left on curb overnight after emptied.
- Yard debris or trash is not permitted in view of street or adjoining residences or public places.
- Broken and unsafe fences must be repaired, replaced or removed.
- Pool ladders must not be left in pools that are not fenced in. Remove ladder when not in use.
- Brush and lawn bags should not be placed on curbs sooner than the Friday before pick up begins.
- No overnight parking on any city streets: 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., November 1st until April 1st.
- No overnight street parking in the downtown business district year around.

Additional information:

- Please have your house numbers visible from the road. In case of an emergency, we need to be able to find your address quickly.
- Please keep the area around fire hydrants accessible to the fire department (clear from snow/brush).
