

2020 Residential Loose-Leaf Pick-Up

Dates:

- **Friday, October 9th - Start raking out leaves**
- **Monday, October 12th - Leaf pick-up begins**
- **Sunday, November 22nd - Last day to rake out leaves***
- **Monday, November 23-25 – Street sweeping**

*The City may offer an additional pick-up after this date, if time and weather allow. Please do not rake leaves out after November 22nd unless we have announced an additional pick-up. In order to have the streets properly swept, the roadway must be cleared by November 22nd.

Loose leaves can be put into the road anytime between October 9th and November 22nd. The Department of Public Works will come multiple times throughout this time period to remove the leaves.

Leaves must be raked all the way into the road, not on the curb lawn. **For safety reasons, residents living along M-89 (E Bridge and Allegan St.) are not eligible for loose leaf pickup, and will need to bag their leaves and place them on the curb lawn.**

In order to eliminate potential hazards and for the cleanliness of our right-of-ways, please do not put leaves in the street after November 22nd. In addition to keeping our streets clean, we also want to avoid having leaves in the street when it begins snowing, as plow trucks will end up pushing the leaves back into the grass.

The City understands that some trees will not have shed all of their leaves by November 22nd. In order to provide the best possible customer service we will schedule an additional loose leaf pick-up in the spring.

If you are too late to rake out your leaves, we have two options: You can bag leaves for monthly collection the first Monday of every month, or you can take them to the compost pile at Public Works free of charge. Please contact the Department of Public Works with any questions: 269-685-9363
